Part A: Preparing for Housing Search

These first steps are the things you need to have a successful housing search:

- A source of income (Ontario Works, employment, etc.),
- Government issued identification (driver's license, OHIP card),
- Housing and credit references,
- Housing needs and preferences,
- And knowledge of the tenant rights you will have depending on the unit you choose.

Part B: Searching for Housing

- Find vacancies that match your budget and needs.
- Contact landlords to view available units.

Part C: Securing Housing and Making It A Home

These last 4 steps will finalize the lease and allow you to move in!

- Signing the lease to confirm you are going to be renting the unit.
- Paying first and last month's rent.
- Set up your utilities account with the new address.
- Move in and set up your home!
