


The Region of Durham

Objective: To build a strong and resilient economy that maximizes opportunities for business and employment growth, innovation and partnership.




- 3.1 Position Durham Region as the location of choice for business

- 4.4 Expand access to existing life stabilization programs




Goal 5: Service Excellence
