


Invasive Pneumococcal Disease in Durham Region 2017-2021

Invasive pneumococcal disease is caused by bacteria that is spread through close contact with someone carrying the bacteria in their nose and mouth







Pneumococcal vaccine is recommended for:

- Routine immunization of infants and children
- People at high risk due to underlying medical conditions, residents of long-term care facilities, adults at high risk due to lifestyle factors
- Anyone 65 and older
