How the potential IPAC lapse was identified: Complaint

Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

Observed nail instruments, equipment, and work surfaces to be improperly cleaned and/or disinfected after each use. Nail instruments and items stored in an unsanitary manner. Observed used single-use items not discarded after use. Manicure clients were not instructed to perform hand hygiene before manicure service performed. Surfaces made of absorbent material. Observed expired hand sanitizer.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all reusable instruments after each use.
- Operator to ensure instruments are fully immersed in the disinfectant solution.
- Operator to store all nail instruments, single-use items, and equipment in a sanitary manner.
- Operator to ensure client's hands are cleaned prior to the service.

- Operator to ensure all instruments are properly disinfected with an appropriate level of disinfectant.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all surfaces that come into contact with client after each use.
- Operator to ensure all surfaces are made of non-absorbent, easily cleanable material.
- Operator to ensure hand sanitizer is not expired.
