Observed wax dispensed in a manner that contaminated the product. Observed aesthetic tools stored in a manner that doesn't prevent contamination of the product. Observed tools to be improperly cleaned. Observed single-use items not discarded immediately after each client. Manicure clients were not instructed to perform hand hygiene prior to service.

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all reusable nail/aesthetic tools
- Operator to dispense products in a manner to prevent from contamination
- Operator to store all clean implements in a manner to prevent from contamination and in clean, covered containers
- Operator to ensure client's hand are cleaned prior to the service
