COVID-19 Mass Immunization Clinics Wind Down

Due to a decreased demand at mass immunization clinics (MICs) and in alignment with provincial direction, the Health Department will gradually close MICs in August and September and transition to offering COVID-19 immunization to Durham Residents via targeted pop-up and mobile clinics.
