COVID-19 Vaccine Resource for Healthcare Providers

To address patient confidence in COVID-19 vaccines there is a dedicated resource - https://tools.cep.health/tool/covid-19-vaccines/#ensuring-patient-confidence-in-vaccines. Recent updates include:

- AstraZeneca Vaccine (e.g. Does AstraZeneca vaccine cause blood clots?)
- Vaccine efficacy
- Vaccine development and approval process
- Special Populations and contraindications
- Vaccine safety and adverse events
- Religious beliefs (e.g. Are the approved vaccines considered halal?)
- Dedicated information on understanding vaccine hesitancy of Black and Indigenous communities

The vaccine site is part of CEP's larger <u>COVID-19 Resource Centre</u>. This is an actively-updated resource hub for healthcare providers as these resources hold the latest, practical, evidence-based information.
