## Book your COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment Now!

You have been identified as a frontline health care worker to receive the Pfizer vaccine based on guidance from the Ministry of Health. The following priority groups **do not** include office staff and include those who provide in person services only.

- 1) Mental Health/Addictions providers
- 2) Developmental services providers
- 3) Campus health care providers
- 4) Social work/social services providers
- 5) Independent Health providers (optometrists, opticians, podiatrists, audiologists, nutritionists)
- 6) Congregate Living staff

You may book your vaccine appointment through Lakeridge Health (<u>COVIDvaccine.lh.ca</u>) at the Durham College and Ontario Tech University site.

- 1) Non-acute rehab and therapy providers (physiotherapy, occupational therapy, registered massage therapy, chiropractic, kinesiology, psychology)
- 2) Naturopath and Holistic Care providers

Please note that all who come for an appointment will be required to show proof that they are a member of the current priority populations and that they live or work in Durham Region. Acceptable proof includes a professional credential, ID badge or pay stub, and acceptable proof of Durham residency includes driver's license, tax bill, and credit card or bank statements.

If you have received this Fax about but are not part of the currently eligible population, we will provide information as soon as possible about when you will be prioritized to receive vaccine.
