## It's Time to Spring Forward and Change Your Batteries

Vaccine thermometer batteries should be changed every six months to ensure fridge monitoring is accurate and cold chain is maintained (Daylight Savings Time is a helpful reminder). Spring is also a great time for a spring cleaning of your vaccine fridge.

## Spring cleaning checklist:

- □ Check the expiry dates of all vaccines and diluents. Ensure all expired products are removed from the fridge and returned to the Durham Region Health Department.
- □ Store vaccines in original packaging and organize by product.
- □ Maintain space between vaccines to allow for air circulation and store vaccine on internal shelves.
- □ Ensure no food, beverages, or specimens are in the vaccine fridge. Cold water bottles are permitted to assist with the regulation of fridge temperatures.

As a reminder, please call the Durham Region Health Department immediately if fridge temperatures go below +2 °C or above +8 °C. Report all cold chain incidents by calling 905-668-7711 ext. 3063.
