World TB Day

World TB Day, falling on **March 24th** each year, is designed to build public awareness that tuberculosis (TB) remains an epidemic in much of the world today. The theme identified by Stop TB Partnership for World TB Day 2024 is: Yes! We Can End TB.

Tuberculosis is preventable, treatable, and curable with publicly funded medications.

Did you know...

On average, **5-10%** of individuals who have latent tuberculosis infection (LTBI) **will develop active TB** during their lifetime (Canadian Tuberculosis Standards, 8th edition, 2022).

There were **360 LTBI cases** reported to Durham Region Health Department in 2023.

There are **effective treatments** in preventing the progression of LTBI to active TB disease, including rifampin self-administered daily for four months (Canadian Tuberculosis Standards – 8th Edition, 2022).

There are **six Durham Region pharmacies** (Neighbourly Pharmacy Inc.) that can dispense publicly funded TB medications to eligible clients.
