



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION GROWING DURHAM - OUR FUTURE, OUR COMMUNITY



Durham Region has initiated a comprehensive **Growth Plan Implementation Study** to develop leading edge, sustainable and responsible long-range planning solutions for the future growth and development of the Region.

Among other matters, the Study will consider directions for future growth and recommend the policies needed to implement a preferred growth option for the Region. The study results will form the basis for amendments to the Durham Regional Official Plan to implement the Provincial Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe.

The Region's consultants have completed the first report, in a series of four, entitled, **Growing Durham, Growth Plan Implementation Study – Draft Phase 1 & 2: Summary of Understanding and Initial Analysis**. The report summarizes the consultant's initial observations on growth issues and priorities and outlines the initial analysis of how forecasted growth may be accommodated.
