

Online Immunization Reporting and Viewing

Every time your child gets immunized you need to report it to the Durham Region Health Department.

You can view or report immunizations online using the **Immunization Connect Ontario (ICON) Tool**. ICON allows you to report and view your child's immunizations online any time. Please also attach a photo of the record.



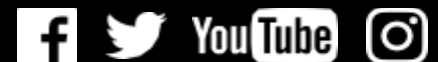
To report online, you will need the student's health card

Immunization Connect Ontario (ICON) Reporting Tool

If entering vaccine information online using ICON, please type the vaccine type as is written below.

2 months of age (Three immunizations due)

- DTaP-IPV-Hib** Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine
- Pneu-C** Pneumococcal conjugate 13 vaccine (Ex. Prevnar 13 ®)
- Rot-5** Rotavirus vaccine (Ex. RotaTeq ®)

4 months of age (Three immunizations due)

- DTaP-IPV-Hib** Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine
- Pneu-C** Pneumococcal conjugate 13 vaccine (Ex. Prevnar 13 ®)
- Rot-5** Rotavirus vaccine (Ex. RotaTeq ®)

6 months of age (Two immunizations due)

- DTaP-IPV-Hib** Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine
- Rot-5** Rotavirus vaccine (Ex. RotaTeq ®)

12 months of age (Three immunizations due)

- MMR** Measles, mumps and rubella vaccine (Ex. Priorix ®, M-M-R II ®)
- Men-C-C** Meningococcal conjugate type C vaccine (Ex. Menjugate ®, Meningitec ®, NeisVac-C ®)
- Pneu-C** Pneumococcal conjugate 13 vaccine (Ex. Prevnar 13 ®)

***Doses of MMR vaccine, Men-C-C vaccine and Pneu-C-13 vaccine are needed on or after age one regardless of previous doses.**

15 months of age (One immunization due)

- Var** Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine

18 months of age (One immunization due)

- DTaP-IPV-Hib** Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine

4 years of age (Two immunizations due)

- Tdap-IPV** Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis and polio vaccine (Ex. Adacel-Polio ®)
- MMRV** Measles, mumps, rubella and varicella vaccine (Ex. Priorix-Tetra ®, ProQuad ®)

*** A dose of Tdap-IPV vaccine is needed on or after 4 years of age regardless of previous doses.**

Grade 7 vaccines (Report online ONLY if it was received outside of Durham Region Health, i.e. school or catchup)

- Men-C-ACYW135** -Meningococcal conjugate type ACYW135 vaccine (Ex. Menveo ®, Menactra ®, Nimenrix ®)
- HB** Hepatitis B (Ex. Recombivax ®, Engerix B ®)
- HPV9** Human papillomavirus (Ex. Gardasil 9 ®)

14- 16 year old booster (10 year booster) -- Most common missing vaccine for high school students

- Tdap** Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis vaccine (Ex. Adacel ®, Boostrix ®)
