Official Contest Rules and Regulations for Bike Month Bingo

Eligibility

The contest is open to all residents of Regional Municipality of Durham with a primary residence in the Regional Municipality of Durham, age 18 years and older, except for elected officials and employees of The Regional Municipality of Durham and any of the sponsoring companies or affiliated companies. This includes their immediate families, cohabitants, agents or contractors.

The Regional Municipality of Durham reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility in a form satisfactory to it, to verify the eligibility of an entrant. Failure to provide proof to the satisfaction of The Regional Municipality of Durham may result in the disqualification of the entrant, at the sole discretion of The Regional Municipality of Durham.

The contest is void where prohibited or restricted by law. The Regional Municipality of Durham reserves the right to cancel the contest or modify these rules at its discretion without prior notice or obligation. Decisions of The Regional Municipality of Durham will be final and binding on all entrants without right of appeal. No purchase is necessary. All disputes will be resolved in the applicable courts in The Regional Municipality of Durham and governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario. The social media promotion, contest, giveaway or sweepstake is subject to all Federal, Provincial and Municipal laws.

Contest details

- The contest begins at 12:01 am EST on Thursday, June 1st, 2023 and ends at 11:59 pm EST on Friday, June 30th, 2023.
- No purchase is required.
- Visit <https://www.durham.ca/bikemonth> to download the Bike Month Bingo card.
- You are responsible for printing the Bike Month Bingo card.
- At your own pace and by choosing your own routes, complete one or more of the tasks on the bingo card.
- As you complete tasks, cross them off on the card.
- Once you have completed five tasks in a row (across, up and down, diagonally), you can claim bingo. To claim bingo, post a photo of your bingo card on social media. Posts must

tag @RegionofDurham and use the #CycleDurham hashtag. Players who don't want to use social media can send a photo of their card to activetransportation@durham.ca.

- Bingo can be claimed each time a row is completed.
- You can claim up to five (5) extra entries into the prize draw by sharing photos of your completed tasks. Each individual photo counts as one (1) extra entry up to the maximum of five (5). You may submit more than five (5) photos, but each additional photo beyond five (5) will not count as an extra entry. Note that duplicate photos of the same location/subject will be counted as one (1) entry.
- There is a total of eight (8) prizes to be won.
- Eight (8) winners will be randomly selected from the pool of entrants.
- The first prize is a \$100 gift certificate from Northern Cycle; the second prize is a \$50 e-gift card (choice from a list of select businesses); the third prize is a \$50 e-gift card (choice from a list of select businesses); the fourth prize is a \$50 e-gift card (choice from a list of select businesses); the fifth prize is a Bike Month Prize Pack (assorted promotional items); the sixth prize is a Bike Month Prize Pack (assorted promotional items); the seventh prize is a Bike Month Prize Pack (assorted promotional items); the eighth prize is a Bike Month Prize Pack (assorted promotional items).

All entries submitted by mail must be received by The Regional Municipality of Durham before Friday June 30th, 2023 at 11:59 pm EST. One entry by mail per person.

Photos

All photo entries must be photographs taken within Durham Region. Content alteration of photo submissions is not acceptable, including combining multiple photos. Cropping of photos is permitted, tonal or colour corrections are acceptable. Borders, frames, text or other graphic treatments are not permitted. Entrants must own all rights to the photographs submitted. As such, entrants hold The Regional Municipality of Durham and the contest sponsors harmless from any breach of copyright. Photographs that have won any other contests or have been published in a magazine or newspaper (except online) are not eligible. Photographs that violate or infringe upon another person's copyright are not eligible. For a photo in which a person is recognizable, photo consent is required. Photo consent releases are the responsibility of the entrant and must be presented in the event the photo is a winner.

The Regional Municipality of Durham holds the right to disqualify entries with inappropriate content.

Judging and Publication

The winner(s) will be selected based on a random draw from all eligible entries received before the deadline. Prizes will be awarded in the order that the names are selected.

Winner(s)' names and/or photographs may be published across The Regional Municipality of Durham's social media channels and other marketing publications. The Regional Municipality of Durham reserves the non-exclusive right to publish any entry and/or use any entry in promotional and advertising materials. The Region reserves the right to request promotional rights from the entrant for the purposes of additional marketing.

The odds of winning are dependent on the number of eligible entries received. Following the deadline, the selected entrant(s) will be notified by email. Selected entrant(s) must correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question to become an official winner and claim the prize. Winner(s) will be announced by Friday, July 21st, 2023, 4:00 pm EST.
