



Non-Profit Organization Training and Events Calendar Guidelines and Criteria for Submission

Purpose: The Non-Profit Organization Training and Events calendar is an online resource where municipalities and other organizations may share capacity-building opportunities for local non-profit and charitable organizations to attend.

Examples of approved submissions include:

1. Learning and training opportunities specifically intended for non-profit and charitable organizations, such as grant writing workshops, board governance training, seminars or webinars themed to sector-specific issues, or training opportunities for staff of sector organizations.
2. Events for non-profit and charitable sector organizations that are focused on strategy, policy and strengthening community impact, such as meetings, conferences, professional development and seminars.

Please note that we may not list certain types of events, including but not limited to:

Fundraising events or initiatives, annual openings of seasonal attractions, permanent collections, school events, receptions, open houses, reunions, anniversaries, meals, beauty pageants, fashion shows, dances, galas, parties, board or card games, bingo, film (except sector-specific films), sing-alongs, children's recitals, school concerts, children's and local sports competitions, garage sales, sidewalk sales, church and hospital bazaars, political events, community service functions and/or religious celebrations; please note some of these may be included when they are part of a categorized event.
