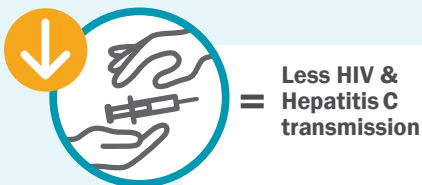

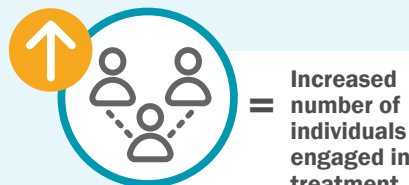
What is Suboxone Treatment?

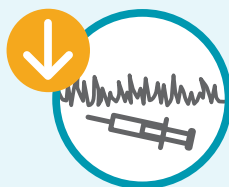
Reduced sharing of needles
