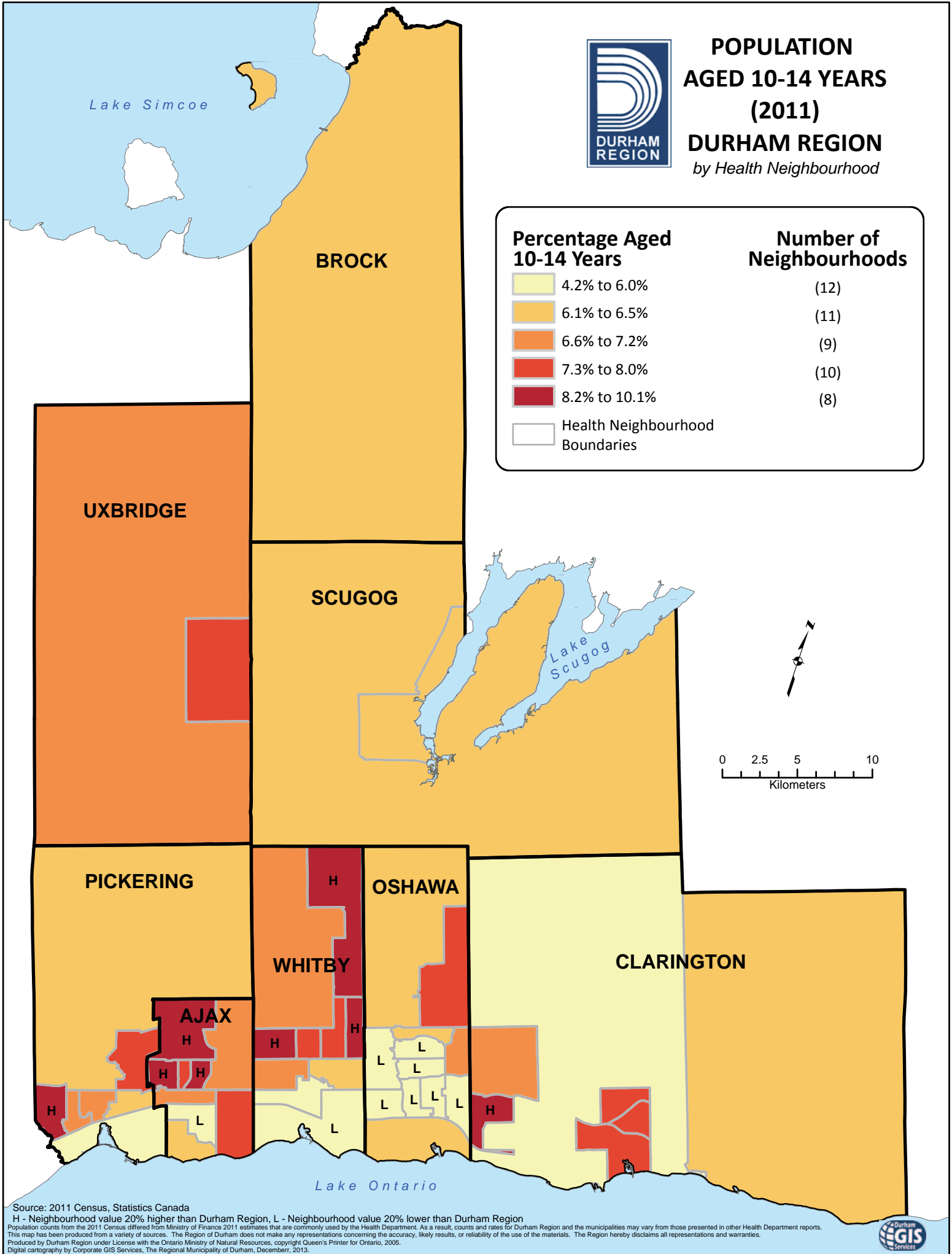
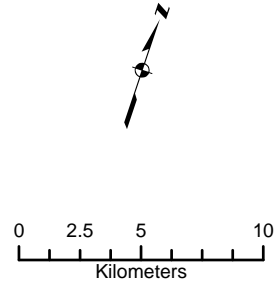

What You Need to Know

- The population aged 10-14 ranges by Health Neighbourhood from 4.2% to 10.1%.
- The mix of age groups impacts the health and general characteristics of the Neighbourhood.

Indicator Notes

- The percentage aged 10-14 is calculated by dividing the number of people aged 10-14 years by the total population, multiplied by 100.
- Source: 2011 Census, Statistics Canada.
- Population counts from the 2011 Census differed from the Statistics Canada 2011 estimates that are commonly used by the Health Department, which are adjusted for undercounts. As a result, counts and rates for Durham Region and the municipalities may vary from those presented in other Health Department reports.
- Neighbourhoods were sorted into quintiles (5 groupings) based on the number of people in that specific age group, i.e., quintiled by population count. This means that approximately 20% of those aged 10-14 in Durham Region are in each quintile.
- Lower refers to at least 20% lower than the Durham Region percentage. Higher refers to at least 20% higher.
