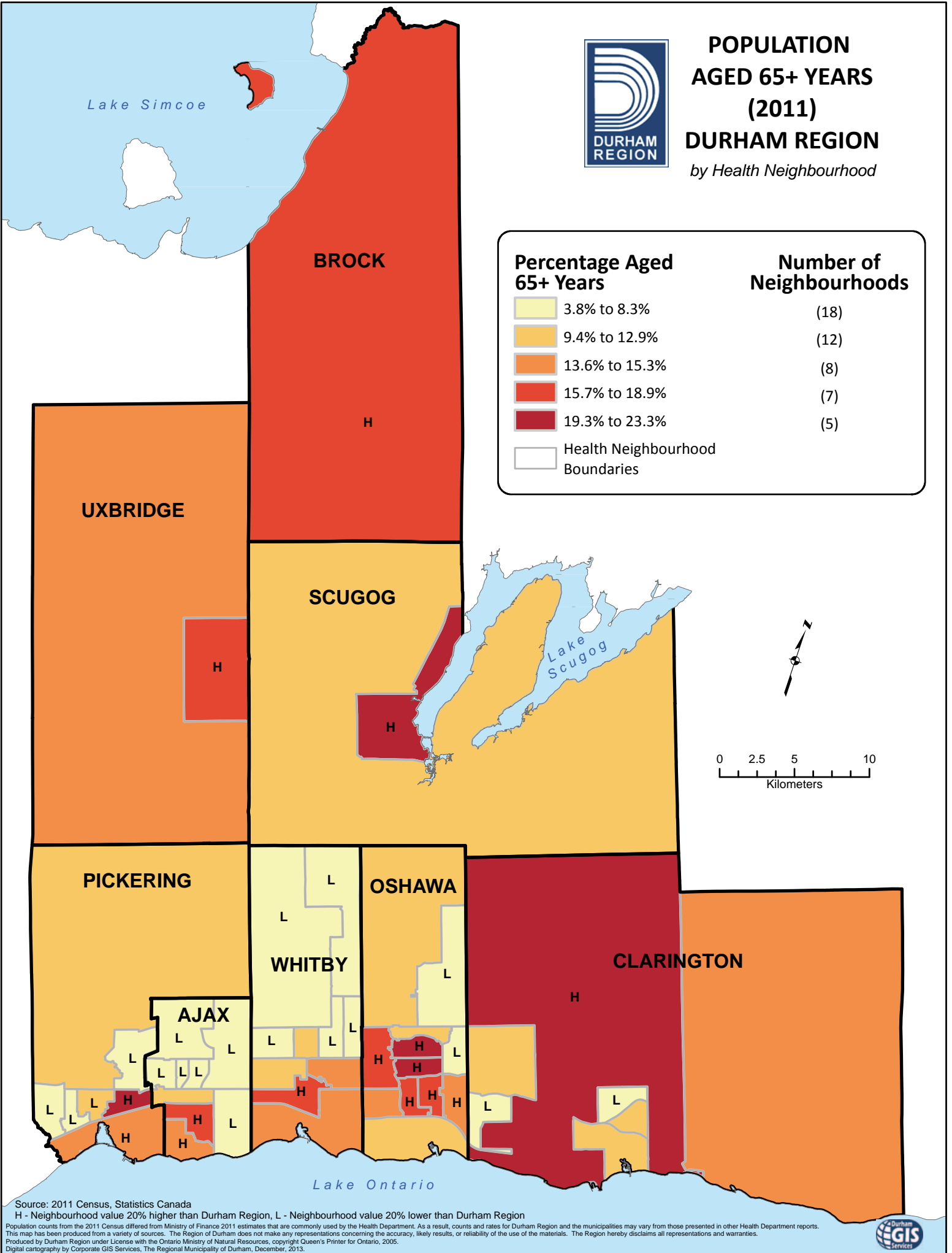

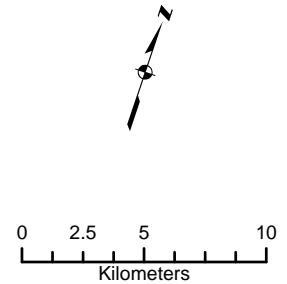

What You Need to Know

- The population aged 65+ ranges by Health Neighbourhood from 3.8% to 23.3%.
- The mix of age groups impacts the health and general characteristics of the Neighbourhood.
- The Neighbourhoods with the highest populations of seniors tend to be downtown Neighbourhoods and the more established areas close to downtown, as well as rural communities such as Darlington and Brock, and towns within rural communities such as Port Perry and Urban Uxbridge. The mix of age groups impacts the health and general characteristics of the Neighbourhood.

Indicator Notes

- The percentage aged 65+ is calculated by dividing the number of people aged 65+ years by the total population, multiplied by 100.
- Source: 2011 Census, Statistics Canada.
- Population counts from the 2011 Census differed from the Statistics Canada 2011 estimates that are commonly used by the Health Department, which are adjusted for undercounts. As a result, counts and rates for Durham Region and the municipalities may vary from those presented in other Health Department reports.
- Neighbourhoods were sorted into quintiles (5 groupings) based on the number of people in that specific age group, i.e., quintiled by population count. This means that approximately 20% of those aged 65 or older in Durham Region are in each quintile.
- Lower refers to at least 20% lower than the Durham Region percentage. Higher refers to at least 20% higher.
