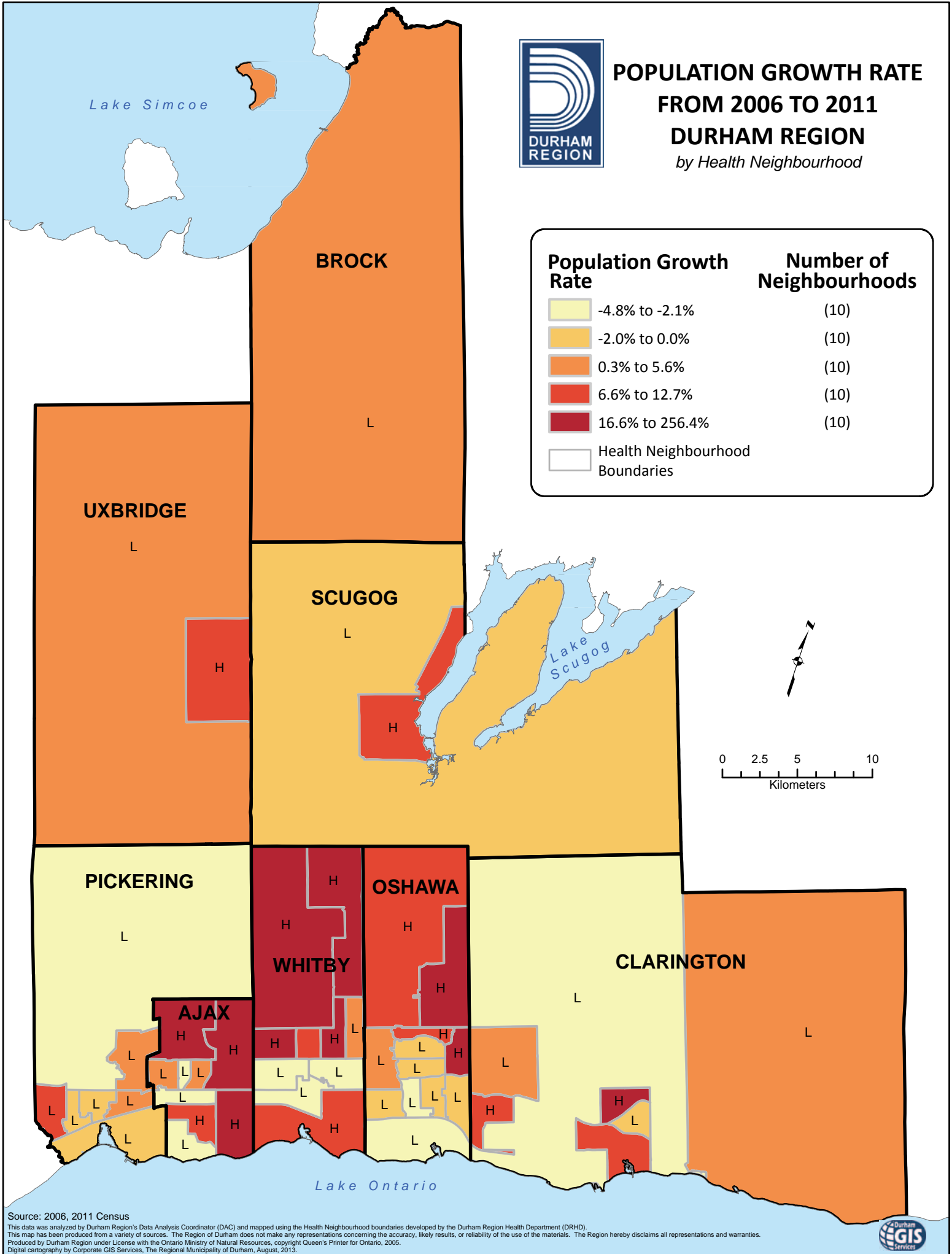
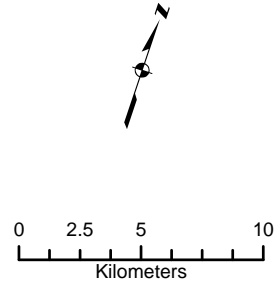

What You Need to Know

- The population growth rate ranges by Health Neighbourhood from -4.8% to 256.4%.
- The Neighbourhoods with the highest growth are those in northern Ajax, Whitby and Oshawa, and other areas with new housing developments. Many of the Neighbourhoods with the highest growth rates also have high birth rates as well.

Indicator Notes

- The population growth rate reflects how much the population grew in the five years between 2006 and 2011. It is calculated by subtracting the 2006 population count from the 2011 population count and dividing by the 2006 population count, multiplied by 100.
- Source: 2006, 2011 Census, Statistics Canada.
- Population counts from the Census differed from Statistics Canada estimates that are commonly used by the Health Department. As a result, counts and rates for Durham Region and the municipalities may vary from those presented in other Health Department reports.
- Neighbourhoods were sorted into five groupings (quintiles) based on the population growth rate. Approximately 10 Neighbourhoods are in each quintile.
- Lower refers to at least 20% lower than the Durham Region rate. Higher refers to at least 20% higher.
