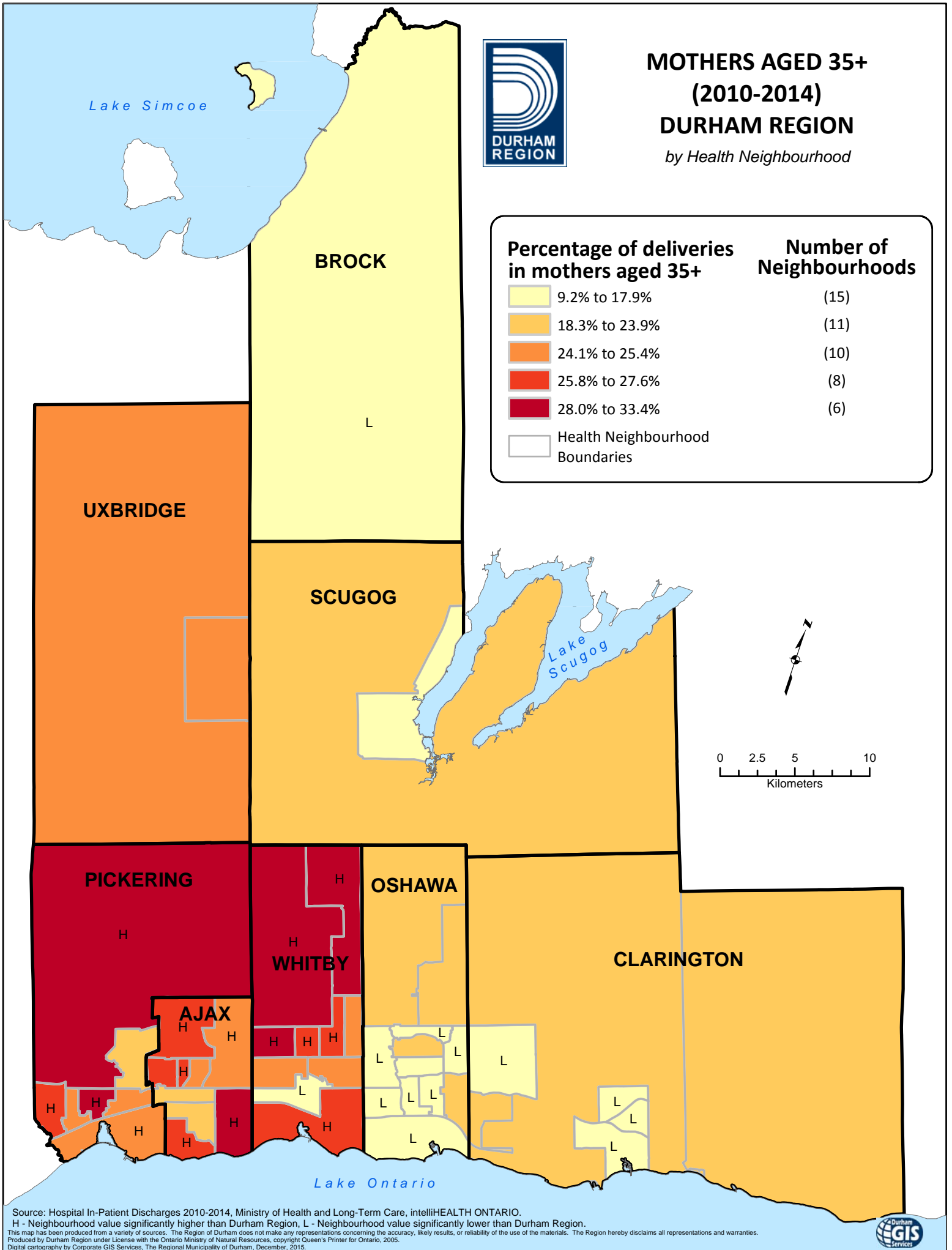

What You Need to Know

- This indicator is classified as neutral in terms of health. An older age of mother after age 35 is associated with some increased health risks for mother and baby, such as preterm birth. However, some health outcomes may also be more positive for older mothers as they tend to have higher education levels and be more financially secure.
- The percentage ranges by Health Neighbourhood from 9.2% to 33.4%.
- There are higher percentages of older mothers in Whitby and Pickering, with the highest percentages in the Neighbourhoods of Williamsburg, Dunbarton, Pickering North and Brooklin West.

Indicator Notes

- This indicator measures the percentage of deliveries that are among mothers aged 35 years or older. It is calculated by dividing the number of deliveries among mothers aged 35+ by the total number of deliveries, multiplied by 100.
- Source: Hospital In-Patient Discharges 2010-2014, Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, IntelliHEALTH ONTARIO.
- Deliveries include both live births and stillbirths and were determined using Z37 codes on the maternal hospital record. A multiple birth is counted as one delivery.
- Neighbourhoods were sorted by the percentage of deliveries to mothers aged 35+ and divided into quintiles (five equal groupings) based on the total number of deliveries to older mothers in those Neighbourhoods, i.e., quintiled by the number of deliveries. This means that for Quintile 5, close to 20% of the deliveries to older mothers in Durham Region were in six Neighbourhoods.
- Neighbourhoods were compared with Durham Region based on their confidence intervals. Those with rates that were lower or higher had 95% confidence intervals that did not overlap with those of Durham Region and were significantly different.
