

Roadmap to Reopening - Step 3 Measures and Requirements

General Rules



- Requirement for all businesses, places, facilities or establishments to prepare and make available a [safety plan](#).
- Requirement for mask/face coverings in indoor public spaces, subject to limited exemptions.
- Requirement for mask/face coverings at indoor workplaces including vehicles that are operating as part of the business or organization, subject to limited exemptions.
- Recommend wearing a mask/face covering outdoors when unable to maintain 2 metres physical distancing from others outside their household.
- Screening of patrons is required, in accordance with instructions issued by the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health.
- Active screening is required for employees and essential visitors. Active screening is required for patrons in certain settings.
- Workers coming within 2 metres of an individual not wearing a mask/face covering indoors must wear personal protective equipment (eye protection and medical/procedure mask).
- Work remotely, where possible.

Organized Public Events, Social Gatherings, and Religious Services, Rites and Ceremonies



- Indoor social gatherings and private events are permitted with up to 25 people and outdoor events/gatherings with up to 100 people.
 - Gathering limit for religious services, wedding ceremonies and funeral services: Indoor and outdoor capacity is limited to the number of people that can maintain 2 metres physical distancing.
- Note:** These limits do not apply to social gatherings associated with religious services, wedding ceremonies or funeral services.
