



The Region of Durham COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics are by appointment only. As per Ministry of Health guidance, COVID-19 vaccinations can only be given to the following priority populations at this time.

To book an appointment you will need to provide the following information:

- Telephone number (home or cell phone)
- Home address including postal code
- Email address (can be family support person)
- Health Card Number

Please review this list carefully to see if you meet the eligibility requirements:

You will be turned away if you are unable to provide proof.

- Adults 80 years or older, or who will be turning 80 in 2021
- Indigenous adult and adult household member
- Primary health care provider and office staff
- Community based medical specialists and office staff
- Pharmacist and pharmacy staff (those who work directly in the pharmacy)
- Walk-in clinic and walk in clinic staff
- Dentistry/oral surgeon and office staff
- Midwifery practice and office staff
- NP-led clinic and office staff
- Community health centre staff
- Firefighters (medical first responders)
- Long-term care and retirement home staff and essential caregivers
- Hospital worker with direct patient care
- Hospital non patient-facing staff
- Lab/diagnostic service - health care provider or office staff
- Police (who act as medical first responders)
- Mental health/addictions/developmental services/campus health
- Social work/social services (providing in person services)
- Non-acute rehab and therapy
- Naturopath and holistic care (direct patient care)
- Congregate living staff
- Independent health
- Diagnostic imaging staff
- Chronic home care patients 16 years of age and older

Important:

1. Ensure you bring proof of eligibility
Acceptable proof of eligibility includes:
 - i. Document showing professional certification/registration/membership
 - ii. Pay stub showing employment at an eligible facility

- iii. ID badge from an eligible facility
 - iv. Letter from your employer on office overhead
 - v. Blank appointment card from your facility indicating you work there
2. Ensure you bring proof that you live or work in the Region of Durham.
 - i. Official documentation (e.g. Driver's License) showing address in Durham Region
 - ii. Bank statement or credit card showing address
 - iii. Pay stub from a place of work in Durham Region

You will be turned away if you are unable to provide proof.

Note: Our clinics are large, spread out and will require periods of waiting in line. If you have mobility needs, please consider bringing a support person and/or mobility aid.

Do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your appointment.

Carefully review the following questions:

1. Do you have any allergies to the vaccine components (Moderna, Pfizer)?
2. Have you ever had a severe allergic reaction?
3. Do you have any other active infection?
4. Are you experiencing signs/symptoms of COVID-19 infection?

If you answer yes to any question, 1-4, please contact your doctor. We cannot vaccinate you at this time.

5. Do you have an uncontrolled bleeding disorder?
6. Are you immunosuppressed due to disease or treatment, or do you have an autoimmune disorder?
7. Are you or could you be pregnant?
8. Are you breastfeeding?

If you answer yes to any question, 5-8, consult with your doctor prior to booking a vaccination appointment. If unable to reach your physician, you may access a virtual medical consult, click here <https://durhamvirtualurgentcare.lh.ca/>.

If you have already consulted with your doctor and you can receive the vaccination, continue to next question.

9. Have you ever had a serious reaction following immunization that has not been investigated?

If you answer yes to question 9, please contact the Durham Region Health Connection Line at 1-800-841-2729 or 905-668-2020 prior to booking a vaccination appointment. We need to follow-up to ensure it is safe for you to receive the vaccine at our clinic.

Our clinics are a scent-free environment, please do not use/wear any scented products when you attend your appointment. There is no food or drink permitted inside the clinic.
