How the potential IPAC lapse was identified: Complaint

Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

Observed clean nail implements stored with/contaminated by a used/soiled implement. Observed implements being improperly disinfected. Observed soiled disinfectant container and solution. Observed single-use items not discarded immediately after each client. Observed sharps being discarded into an unapproved sharps container. Also, completed accidental exposure records were not on-site.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to clean reusable nail implements by using a clean, dedicated brush with detergent and water and friction to remove debris prior to disinfection.
- Operator to clean and disinfect the container being used to hold the disinfectant solution for the nail implements after each use.
- Operator to ensure implements are fully immersed in the disinfectant solution for the appropriate contact time.
- Operator to store all clean nail implements in a manner to prevent from contamination.

- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not re-use or share between clients.
- Operator to provide and use an approved sharps container as per Canadian Standards Association standards.
- Operator to keep accidental exposure records on-site for 1 year and readily available in a secure location for at least 2 years thereafter.
