How the potential IPAC lapse was identified: Complaint

Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

Observed nail tools/equipment/surfaces/linens improperly cleaned, disinfected and/ or laundered. Observed single-use items not being discarded immediately after each client. Observed furnishings made of absorbent material. Observed work areas and furnishings maintained in an unsanitary manner. Observed expired hand sanitizer with no Drug Identification Number (DIN) or Natural Product Number (NPN). Incomplete high-level disinfection (HLD) records. HLD not discarded according to manufacturer's instructions. Observed contents of sharps container above the fill line. Completed accidental exposure records not available on-site.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all reusable nail implements and foot baths after each client.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all surfaces that come into contact with client after each use.

- Operator to clean reusable implements by using a clean, dedicated brush with detergent and water and friction to remove debris prior to disinfection.
- Operator to maintain disinfectant as per manufacturer's instructions.
- Operator to ensure clean sheets, linen, towels, etc. maintained in a sanitary manner.
- Operator to ensure all furnishing are made of durable, smooth, non-absorbent, and easy to clean material.
- Operator to ensure all work areas are kept clean and in a sanitary manner.
- Operator to keep accidental exposure records on-site for 1 year and readily available in a secure location for at least 2 years thereafter.
- Operator to ensure hand sanitizer is not expired.
- Operator to ensure hand sanitizer contains a DIN or NPN.
- Operator to ensure HLD disinfection records are maintained.
- Operator must discard full sharps container once it reaches the fill line or ¾ capacity.
