Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

Operator did not maintain proper or complete records for each sterilizer unit.

Efficacy testing for each ultrasonic cleaner and mechanical washer/disinfector was not conducted.

Some used, dental equipment/devices were being improperly cleaned prior to sterilization.

Some equipment/devices in storage observed in closed position inside sterilization pouches.

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

Ensure each sterilizer, mechanical washer/disinfector and ultrasonic cleaner is tested daily for relevant efficacy parameters. Do not use any reprocessing devices that have not been properly tested at start of operating day.

Ensure all re-suable medical equipment/devices that are improperly cleaned are recleaned, repackaged, labeled and sterilized.

Ensure all sterilizing physical parameters are required to be recorded after each cycle, verified daily against USB/Print out records and available on site.

Ensure IPAC policies and procedures are complete and in line with current IPAC guidance.

Ensure proper training is provided to all staff involved with reprocessing.
