- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
- Operator to dispense products in a manner to prevent from contamination.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all reusable implements after each use.
- Operator to ensure to use a scrub brush to properly clean footbath basins after each use.
- Operator to properly disinfect all surfaces that come into contact with clients after each use.
- Operator to ensure all implements are maintained in good repair.
