- Observed sharps container filled pass the fill line and not maintained in a clean and sanitary manner.
- Observed operator failed to clean and disinfect reusable items and/or equipment after each use with the appropriate level of disinfectant.
- Observed personal service products not dispensed in a sanitary manner.
- Observed implements not made of durable, smooth, non-absorbent, and easy to clean material.
- Observed operator not record all required client contact information and document accidental blood and body fluid exposures with the necessary details.
- Observed chemical containers not properly labelled.

## IPAC Lapse Investigation

- Operator to ensure all reusable implements/equipment are cleaned and disinfected with an appropriate level of disinfectant after each use.
- Operator to ensure that personal service products are dispensed in a clean and sanitary manner.
- Operator to ensure all implements are made of durable, smooth, non-absorbent, and easy to clean material.
- Operator to record all required client contact information and document accidental blood and body fluid exposures with the necessary details.
- Operator to ensure chemical containers are properly labelled.
