Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

Operator conducted improper hand hygiene and client's hands were not washed prior to service. New single-use nail items were stored with/contaminated by used single-use nail items. Single-use nail items were not discarded immediately after each client. Wax pot was contaminated. Equipment not properly cleaned and/or disinfected. Product was not properly covered. Surfaces throughout the setting were not in a sanitary manner, not easily cleanable, and/or in poor condition.

- Operator to conduct proper hand hygiene between clients
- Operator to ensure client's hands are cleaned with soap and water prior to procedure

- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use
- Operator to dispense products in a manner to prevent from contamination

- Operator to soak all reusable implements that cannot be reprocessed immediately after use in a labelled, covered container
- Operator to store single-use disposable items and equipment in clean, covered containers
- Operator to separate dirty items from clean items at all times to prevent cross contamination
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all surfaces that come into contact with client after each use
- Operator to ensure floors, surfaces, and furniture are kept in a sanitary manner, are easily cleanable and kept in good repair
