Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

1. Observed contaminated single use items, products and tools stored in unsanitary manner with single use items outside of clean covered containers at work stations.
2. Observed overfilled sharps container.
3. Observed soiled disinfectant solution and non-approved disinfectant products on site.
4. Observed operator disinfecting re-usable tools with non-approved device/method.
5. Observed operator fail to maintain and clean tools/equipment adequately prior to disinfection.
6. Observed operator fail to disinfect tools and equipment with adequate level disinfectant and proper contact time.

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## IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

1. Operator to ensure that all items are stored in sanitary manner inside clean covered containers.
2. Operator to ensure single use items are discarded immediately after each use.
3. Operator to ensure proper cleaning and disinfection of all reusable implements and equipment after each use.
4. Operator to ensure adequate disinfectant (High Level) is used for semi-critical items (grater type foot file).
5. Operator to ensure all equipment is in good repair.
6. Operator to ensure sharps containers are disposed of immediately when filled to marked fill line.
