- Observed accumulation of debris in work station cupboards/drawers and other equipment.
- Observed linens and towels with debris and in an unsanitary manner.
- Observed scoops stored directly in container of product.
- Observed manicure, waxing and eyebrow tinting equipment stored in an unsanitary manner.
- Observed alcohol disinfectant without a Health Canada drug identification number (DIN) or natural product number (NPN).
- Observed single-use items not discarded immediately after each client.
- Observed reusable equipment improperly cleaned and disinfected.

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to routinely clean work areas and equipment daily at a minimum and when visibly soiled.
- Operator to launder linens, sheets, towels, etc. after each use.
- Operator to store and dispense products in a manner to prevent from contamination.

- Operator to store items in clean, covered containers and/or in a sanitary manner.
- Operator to provide and use disinfectant with a Health Canada drug identification number (DIN) or natural product number (NPN).
- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all reusable equipment after each use.
