- Operator to ensure equipment is properly disinfected with an appropriate level of disinfectant
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all foot baths after each client
- Operator to clean nail implements in a dedicated cleaning sink, not a washroom sink
- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients
- Operator to keep a form to record accidental blood and body fluid exposures with the required information
