1. Observed single use wax cartridge not discarded following use.
2. Observed soiled nail service implements stored at workstations (drawers/behind counters)
3. Observed improperly cleaned and improperly disinfected foot files and nail service equipment.
4. Observed clean and disinfected tools stored in unsanitary manner.
5. Observe operator fail to use adequate level of disinfectant for foot files.

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### IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

1. Operator to ensure that all items are stored in sanitary manner inside clean covered containers.
2. Operator to ensure single use items are discarded immediately after each use.
3. Operator to ensure proper cleaning and disinfection of all reusable implements and equipment after each use.
4. Operator to ensure adequate disinfectant (High Level) is used for semi-critical items (grater type foot file).
