- Observed an inappropriate level of disinfectant being used to disinfect nail implements.
- Observed used single-use nail implements not discarded immediately after use.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to ensure implements are fully immersed in the disinfectant solution.
- Operator to clean reusable implements with a clean, dedicated brush, detergent and water and friction prior to disinfection.
- Operator to ensure all implements are disinfected with an appropriate level of disinfectant.
- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
