## Flu Season is Done and Returning has Begun!

According to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, Ontario's influenza season typically runs from October to April. The time has come to **return all influenza vaccine** to the Durham Region Health Department (DRHD).

Please return **influenza vaccine** from your facility by **June 30th**. Vaccine that is being returned to DRHD does **not** need to be returned in cold chain. This vaccine is accounted for and then sent for proper disposal.
