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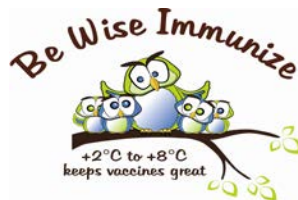
Pharmacy Flu Temperature Log Requirements

Influenza season is just around the corner and the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) has provided Durham Region Health Department (DRHD) with the requirements for temperature log submissions.

Starting the week beginning **September 24, 2018**, pharmacies will be required to submit temperature logs to DRHD on a weekly basis. Temperature logs must be submitted by **Thursday** each week and will be required to be submitted weekly until the end of influenza season.

If temperature logs are not submitted on time or an unreported cold chain failure is identified, sites will be **suspended** from ordering for one week according to MOHLTC.

Temperature logs can be faxed to **905-666-6214**. Please make sure to include your **fridge number** on the top of your temperature log submission and make sure to submit temperature logs from the date of last submission.
