## Pharmacy Flu Temperature Log Requirements

Influenza season is just around the corner! Starting the week of **September 23, 2019** pharmacies will be required to submit temperature logs to the Health Department on a weekly basis until the end of influenza season.

Temperature logs must be submitted by **Thursday** of each week. The first submission is due by September 26, 2019.

If temperature logs are not submitted on time, or an unreported cold chain failure is identified, sites will be **suspended** from ordering for at least **one week** according to requirements from the Ministry of Health. Your **fridge number** must be written on the **top** of your temperature log, otherwise your site is at risk for suspension; submit temperature logs from the date of **last submission**.

Temperature logs can be faxed to **905-666-6214**. If your pharmacy is located in the Townships of Brock, Scugog or Uxbridge, fax temperature logs to **905-982-0840**.
