# Influenza Vaccine Now Available for High-Risk Groups Only

**The influenza vaccine is now available to order for the following high-risk individuals:**

- Pregnant individuals
- Residents, staff, and care providers of congregate living settings
- Individuals 65 years of age and older
- Children 6 months to 4 years of age
- Individuals in or from a First Nations, Inuit, or Métis community
- Members of underserved communities
- Healthcare workers and first responders
- Individuals with significant exposure to birds or mammals (poultry, livestock slaughterhouse, processing plant workers, wildlife officers/researchers, and veterinarians)
- Individuals 6 months of age and older with the following underlying chronic health conditions:
  - Cardiac or pulmonary disorders
  - Diabetes mellitus or other metabolic disease
  - Cancer or renal disease
  - Conditions or medications which compromise the immune system
  - Anemia or hemoglobinopathy
  - Neurologic or neurodevelopmental conditions
  - Class 3 obesity (BMI  $\geq 40$ )
  - Children and adolescents (6 months to 18 years) undergoing treatment with acetylsalicylic acid for long periods

## Co-Administration

Influenza vaccines may be given at the same time, or at any time before or after other vaccines, including COVID-19 and/or respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) vaccines, or RSV monoclonal antibody products. It is recommended to administer the vaccines in separate limbs or separate the injection sites by at least 2.5 cm (1 inch). Different immunization equipment (needle and syringe) must be used for each vaccine.

<sup>a</sup> Egg-allergic individuals may be vaccinated against influenza using the full dose of **any** age-appropriate product.

<sup>b</sup>Thimerosal is present in multidose vials format only.

- Fluzone® and Fluzone® High-Dose are **different products**. Fluzone® High-Dose is authorized **only** for individuals aged 65 years and older. Use caution when administering Fluzone® products.
- For the 2025/2026 influenza season, all Ontario flu vaccines are trivalent vaccines.
- Do not delay vaccination for a particular vaccine product.
- Health care providers should report any adverse event which may be related to receipt of a vaccine, as outlined in [Public Health Ontario's AEFI Reporting fact sheet](#) ([durham.ca/hcp](https://durham.ca/hcp) >Tools >AEFI).

## Ordering

- To order, use the [New Online Seasonal Vaccine Order Form](#) ([durham.ca/hcp](https://durham.ca/hcp) > Forms > Order).
- This year, **vaccine order notifications will be sent by email instead of by phone**. Please note that orders will be ready for **pick-up within 7–10 business days**, and you will receive an email once your order is available. **To prevent delays during pick up, please ensure your vaccine cooler is prepared according to [vaccine storage and handling guidelines](#).**
- Do not book appointments prior to receiving the influenza vaccine and **wait until early November before conducting large-scale clinics** to ensure supply of vaccine is available to meet clinic demands.
