Health Department Launches New Interactive Dashboard for Local Opioid Statistics

Durham Region Health Department has developed a new interactive dashboard to monitor local opioid-related statistics. The new dashboard will replace the current version of the Durham Region Opioid Information System (DROIS) on durham.ca/opioidstats.

Interactive local opioid-related data

The new interactive DROIS dashboard allows users to select data by week, month, or year. A key highlight is the moving averages that were added to the weekly data to help provide context to overall trends.

DROIS provides timely information on local opioid overdose-related statistics including, Region of Durham Paramedic Services (RDPS) response calls, emergency department (ED) visits and opioid-related deaths. Collecting and monitoring this information is important in working to address local opioid-related drug toxicity overdoses and deaths. A key benefit of DROIS is that it provides health and social service providers with local, up-to-date information they can use for service planning.
