



# RSV Prevention Program Update

## Infants and High-Risk Children Program

The Infant and High-Risk Children Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) prevention program will extend into April. This is based on epidemiological data (percent positivity and hospitalizations) which show community transmission of RSV is ongoing. Please continue to administer RSV products to eligible infants and high-risk children at this time.

The decision to administer maternal vaccination should take into consideration the timing of administration during pregnancy (i.e. between 32-36 weeks gestation) and the upcoming timing for the end of the season.

## Older Adult Program

The Ministry of Health (MOH) has advised that the 2025-26 Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) prevention program for older adults will continue throughout the spring and summer (i.e., year-round). Please continue to immunize eligible individuals. Booster doses are not currently recommended for this population.
