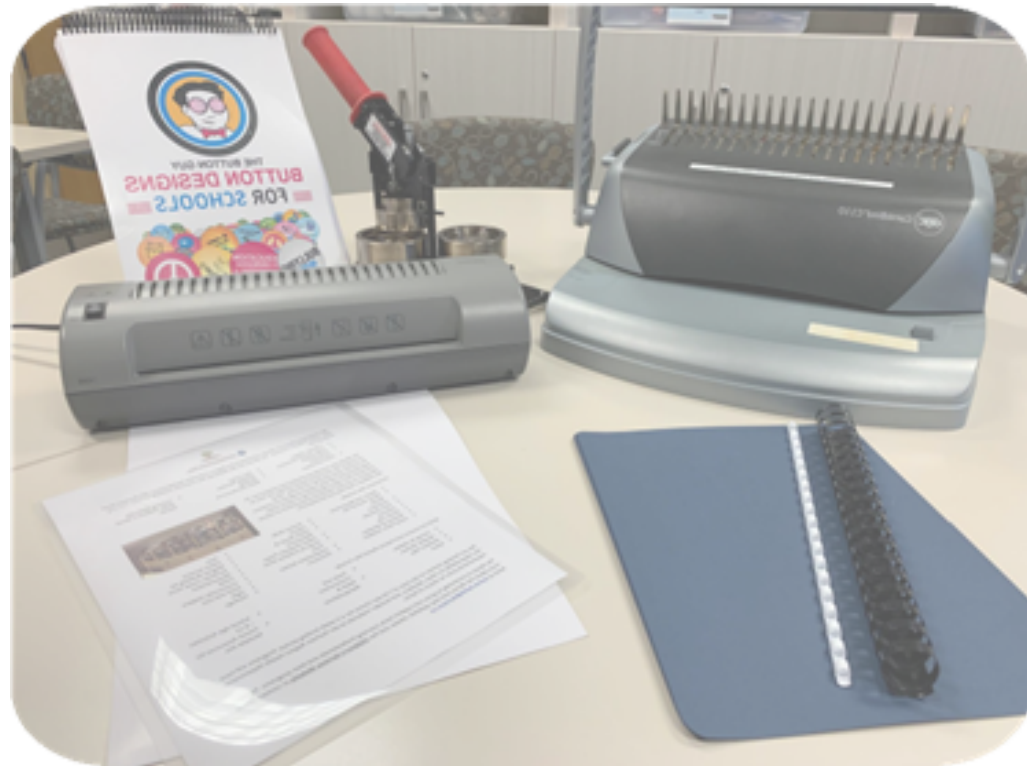




## **The Professional Resource Library**

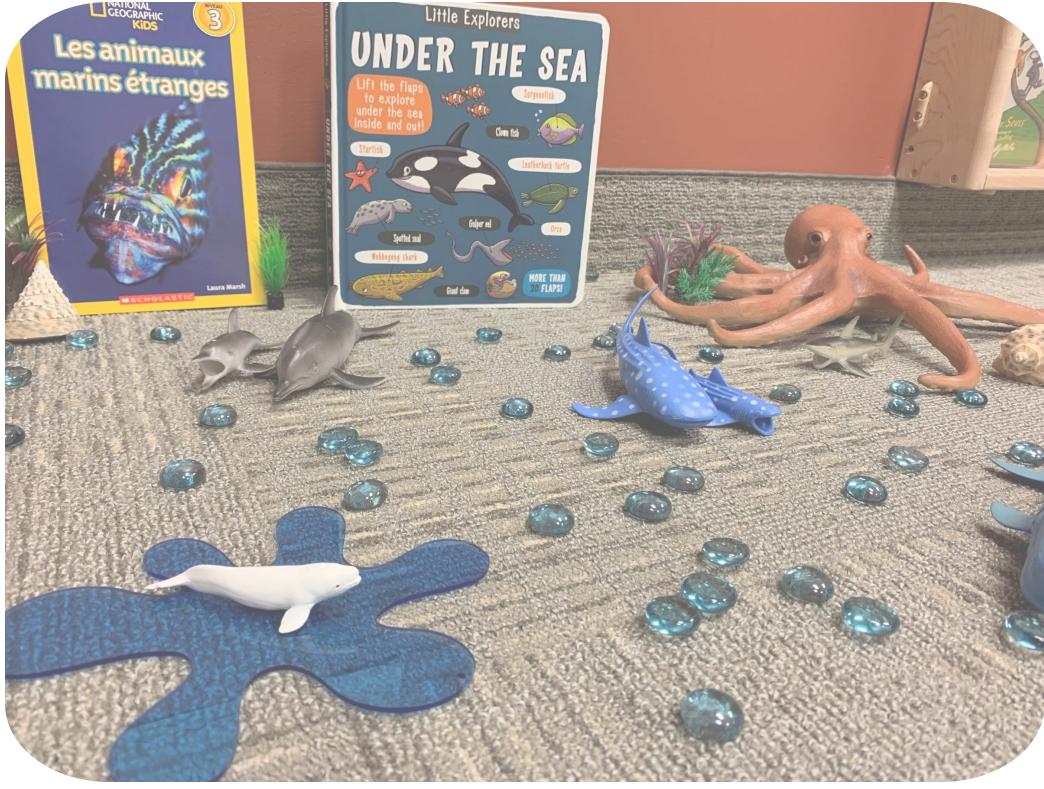
