 overview of their agency. Blue Door has 41 years of experience and welcomes the
 opportunity to be the Operator of this project.
- Alex introduced Amanda and announced that she will be the Manager of this project.

Minutes Beaverton Supportive Housing Liaison Committee October 16th, 2023

- Blue Door has a wide range of programs and services for males, families, youth and those at risk of/or experiencing homelessness. Their program allows individuals to be part of a community and see possibilities to look forward to.
- The program in Beaverton is similar to other projects they operate, and they look forward to bringing best practices from those sites to the Beaverton site.
- Blue Door will connect with Durham Transit and Community Care Durham to discuss transportation services for clients.
- They are excited to bring creativity, innovation, and partnership to the community.
- Blue Door has a social enterprise called Construct. This program provides people
 with a way to supplement their income and get back into the work force. It connects
 people with local unions to get apprenticeships, once they get an apprenticeship
 their wage jumps from minimum wage to \$22-24/hr. This helps to raise them up
 and prepare them for the transition to their own housing.
