



## Free Income Tax Clinics in Durham

These clinics are available for people whose total family income is less than the amount shown in the chart below, and whose tax situation is considered simple.

### Family size income limits

- One person - \$30,000 or less
- Two people - \$40,000 combined (add \$2,500 for each additional person in the family)

A tax situation is considered simple if an individual has no income or if income comes from:

- Employment
- Pension
- Benefits such as Canada Pension Plan, Disability, Canada Child Benefit, Employment Insurance or Ontario Works
- RRSP
- Support payments
- Scholarships, fellowships, bursaries or grants
- Interest (under \$1,000)

A tax situation is not simple when an individual is:

- Self-employed or has employment expenses
- Has business or rental income and expenses
- Has capital gains or losses
- Files for bankruptcy
- Is completing a tax return for a deceased person

During tax season, many clinics can only file current year returns, but some offer multiple year filing. If you need more than one year filed, please discuss this when you book your appointment.

**Tax clinics available outside of tax season:**

**Welcome Centre Immigrant Services - Ajax and Pickering:** Appointments are available until mid-July 2018, for residents who have been in Canada five years or less only. Please call 1-877-761-1155 for an appointment.
