Toronto Pearson generates:

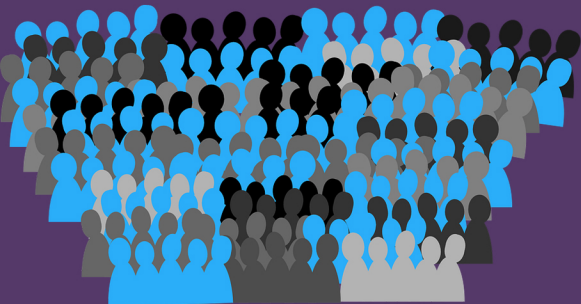
- 317,000 direct & indirect jobs

system capacity



By 2032: annual passenger demand = system capacity

By 2043:

- population of Southern Ontario = 15.5 million
- air travel passengers = 90 million / year
- passenger demand exceeds planned capacity by 20 million / year

getting there



Over the next 30 years, driving time to Pearson will increase 25-35%

The Pickering Airport site is directly adjacent to a 400-series highway, rail routes, regional roads & transit routes.



Toronto Pearson will reach capacity in 22 years. Planning & development of a new airport and related transportation takes time!

- London Heathrow ~ 20 years concept to construction
- UP Express ~ 14 years
