



Council Highlights

February 1, 2023

Key highlights:

The Regional Council Meeting began with a moment of reflection. Chair Henry asked members to keep David Onley, Hazel McCallion, and Tyre Nichols in their thoughts.

Regional Council recognized Black History Month. Chair Henry noted that this is a time to honour and celebrate the contributions of Durham's Black community members and encouraged everyone to participate in events throughout the month of February to honour Black History Month.

Regional Council approved the recommendations of the Finance and Administration Committee, Works Committee, Health & Social Services Committee, Planning & Economic Development Committee, and Committee of the Whole, including the 2023 Regional Business Plans and Property Tax Supported Budget Guideline ([2023-F-1](#)) and development of a Regional Public Art Program ([2023-COW-2](#)).

Regional Council also appointed citizen members to the Land Division Committee and Durham Regional Police Services Board, and debated a motion to request changes to the composition of the Board of Directors for the Durham Region Non-Profit Housing Corporation, which was defeated.
