

### **Region of Durham**

- The Regional Municipality of Durham began operations in 1974 as an upper tier municipality comprised of eight local municipalities
- Durham is one of the fastest growing communities in North America with a current population estimate of 692,000 and is on track to reach nearly one million residents by 2031
- Durham Region encompasses an area of 2,537 square kilometres





#### 2018 Year End Asset Replacement Value (\$14.54 billion)







### Regional Property Tax Supported Budget



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

Annualization of 2019 budget decisions



Removal of one-time items







## 2020 Preliminary Provincial Funding Impacts

- > Uncertainty
- Funding reductions, changes in funding models, and potential downloading



Paramedic Services – \$0.4 million estimate



Public Health – under \$0.1 million estimate



Long-Term Care – \$0.2 million estimate



Social Assistance – \$0.6 million to \$1.6 million estimate



Social Housing - unknown



Children's Services – \$2.5 million estimate
