

What is the Ontario Autism Program - Durham (OAP-D) - Entry to School (ETS) Integrated Service Model?

The Entry to School (ETS) program is an early years program within the new needs-based Ontario Autism Program (OAP). There are two components to the ETS program:

- 1. Getting Ready for School (up to 6 months)
- 2. Transition to School (up to 6 months)

The goals of the 'Getting Ready for School' component are to:

- 1. Prepare a child to successfully transition to school for the first time,
- 2. Investigate and trial supports that can subsequently be used by the educator team in the classroom.

The goals of the 'Transition to School' component are to:

- 1. Generalize skills learned during the 'Getting Ready for School' component to their school,
- 2. Apply the knowledge learned during the 'Getting Ready for School' component to support a successful transition to school.

The ETS Integrated Service Model allows children who are currently enrolled full time within a licensed child care to participate in the 'Getting Ready for School' component of the ETS program, within their child care. This program can:

Support educators to enhance their knowledge of how to support children on the Autism Spectrum by:

- ✓ Providing consultation and coaching services from a team of professionals with enhanced knowledge and experience supporting children on the Autism Spectrum
 - The team includes 3 disciplines: Occupational Therapist (OT), Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP), and Behaviour Consultant (BC)
 - Up to 4 hours/month per discipline of consultation and coaching support can be provided based on needs
- ✓ Increasing access to resources and continuing education opportunities for educators, tailored to a centre's needs and individual learning goals

Support educators and families in the coordination of services by:

- ✓ Clearly outlining roles and responsibilities of ETS and Special Needs Resourcing to prevent duplication of services using an ETS-Collaborative Action Plan
- ✓ This includes streamlining clinical providers whenever possible (e.g., having one OT support the child rather than an ETS OT and Preschool Outreach Program OT)

Provide a guaranteed commitment to:

- ✓ Ongoing collaboration and partnership to ensure our services are a "value added" experience
- ✓ Tailored support to meet the individuals needs of child care centres, educators, and the child
