


# Regional Property Tax Supported Budget



In 2020, the average single detached home in Durham, with a 2020 CVA of \$483,100, will pay approximately \$234 per month, or \$2,803 annually, for Regional property tax supported services.

#### **2021 Council Approved Guideline**

Overall property tax impact not to exceed 2.0 per cent which is a Regional property tax increase of \$5 per month, or \$56 annually for an average residential property owner.
