How the potential IPAC lapse was identified: Complaint

Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

1. Observed accumulation of grime, nail dust, debris, and food at workstations, shelves, reprocessing sink, on cloth and paper liners and contact surfaces not cleaned and disinfected between clients.
2. Observed dirty and clean tools stored together, new single-use items, and open products stored uncovered in the reprocessing area, manicure stations, and aesthetic room.
3. Observed reprocessing area did not have a one-way workflow from dirty to clean.
4. Observed soiled tools left at workstations and reprocessing area, not disassembled, and not cleaned and disinfected after each use, stored soiled for days following use.
5. Observed used single-use items stored in shelves, containers, cabinets, and drawers throughout the facility, and not immediately discarded after use.

## IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

1. Operator to ensure all work and client contact surfaces are cleaned and disinfected immediately following use by a client or after they are contaminated in any way.
2. Operator to ensure that all items are stored in a sanitary manner and inside clean covered containers.
3. Operator to ensure proper dirty to clean process and prompt cleaning and disinfection of all reusable implements and equipment after each use.
4. Operator to ensure all single use items are discarded immediately following use.
