
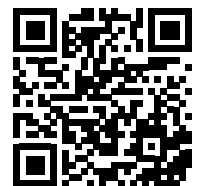


Online Immunization Reporting

Every time your child gets a vaccine you need to report it to the Durham Region Health Department.

You can report vaccines online using the **Online Submission Tool**. If the immunization record is not in English, please have it translated if possible.

3. Follow the instructions

Vaccines by age as per Ontario's Publicly Funded Routine Immunization schedule

2 months of age (Three immunizations due)

- DTaP-IPV-Hib** Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine
- Pneu-C** Pneumococcal conjugate 15 vaccine (Ex. Vaxneuvance ®)
- Rot-1** Rotavirus vaccine (Ex. Rotarix ®)

4 months of age (Three immunizations due)

- DTaP-IPV-Hib** Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine
- Pneu-C** Pneumococcal conjugate 15 vaccine (Ex. Vaxneuvance ®)
- Rot-1** Rotavirus vaccine (Ex. Rotarix ®)

6 months of age (Two immunizations due)

- DTaP-IPV-Hib** Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine

12 months of age (Three immunizations due)

- MMR** Measles, mumps and rubella vaccine (Ex. Priorix ®, M-M-R II ®)
- Men-C-C** Meningococcal conjugate type C vaccine (Ex. Menjugate ®, Meningitec ®, NeisVac-C ®)
- Pneu-C** Pneumococcal conjugate 15 vaccine (Ex. Vaxneuvance ®)

***Doses of MMR vaccine, Men-C-C vaccine and Pneu-C-15 vaccine are needed on or after age one regardless of previous doses.**

15 months of age (One immunization due)

- Var** Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine

18 months of age (One immunization due)

- DTaP-IPV-Hib** Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine

4 years of age (Two immunizations due)

- Tdap-IPV** Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis and polio vaccine (Ex. Adacel-Polio ®)
- MMRV** Measles, mumps, rubella and varicella vaccine (Ex. Priorix-Tetra ®, ProQuad ®)

***A dose of tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis and polio containing vaccine is needed on or after 4 years of age.**

Grade 7 vaccines (ONLY report online if vaccine NOT given at a Durham Region Health Department school or catch-up clinic)

- Men-C-ACYW135** - Meningococcal conjugate type ACYW135 vaccine (Ex. Menveo ®, Menactra ®, Nimenrix ®)
- HB** Hepatitis B (Ex. Recombivax ®, Engerix B ®)
- HPV9** Human papillomavirus (Ex. Gardasil 9 ®)

14- 16 year old booster (10 year booster) - Most common missing vaccine for high school students

- Tdap** Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis vaccine (Ex. Adacel ®, Boostrix ®)
