

Toileting Routine

Important Steps to Remember!

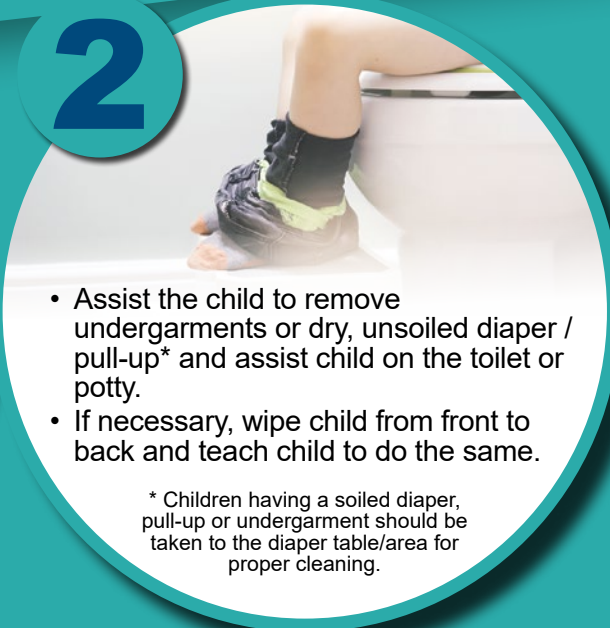


1



- Gather all supplies.
- Perform hand hygiene.
- Disposable gloves are optional but recommended for diarrhea

2



- Assist the child to remove undergarments or dry, unsoiled diaper / pull-up* and assist child on the toilet or potty.
- If necessary, wipe child from front to back and teach child to do the same.

* Children having a soiled diaper, pull-up or undergarment should be taken to the diaper table/area for proper cleaning.

- Remove and discard gloves – if used.
- If hands are visibly soiled, wipe with a moist towelette.
- Perform hand hygiene (e.g. with alcohol-based hand rub).

Diaper and/or dress child.

5



Wash your hands and help child wash theirs.

6



Return child to supervised area.

7



Clean and disinfect** toilet and potty when visibly soiled.

For potty chairs:

- Empty contents into the toilet carefully, to avoid splashing.
- Clean potty with soapy water and empty into toilet.
- Rinse with clean water and empty into toilet. Flush toilet.
- Disinfect potty and use appropriate contact time.
- Store potty in a sanitary manner when not in use.

Wash your hands again.

Follow Step 7 & 8 when cleaning and disinfection of toilets and potty chairs/seats etc. are required.

** For diarrhea and/or outbreaks, use a higher level disinfectant.

(e.g. 5000 parts per million bleach solution for a 10 minute contact time.)
