

BY-LAW NUMBER 24-2014
OF
THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF DURHAM

being a by-law to confirm the proceedings of the Council of the Regional Municipality of Durham at its meeting on the 2nd day of April, 2014.

WHEREAS Subsection 3 of Section 5 of the Municipal Act provides that, a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under Section 8, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and desirable that the proceedings of the Council of the Regional Municipality of Durham at this meeting be confirmed and adopted by By-law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED
as a By-law of the Regional Municipality of Durham by the Council thereof as follows:

1. That the action of the Regional Council at its meeting held on the 2nd day of April, 2014, in respect of each recommendation contained in Report No. 3 of the Health and Social Services Committee, Report No. 4 of the Finance and Administration Committee, Report No. 4 of the Planning and Economic Development Committee and Report No. 4 of the Works Committee, in respect of each motion, resolution and other action passed, and taken by the Regional Council at its meeting, is, except where the prior approval of Ontario Municipal Board is required, hereby adopted, ratified and confirmed as if all such proceedings were expressly embodied in this By-law.

2. That the Chair of the Council and the proper officers of the Regional Municipality of Durham are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said action or to obtain approvals where required, and, except where otherwise provided, the Chair and the Clerk are hereby directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf, and to affix the Corporate Seal of the Regional Municipality of Durham to all such documents.
